HOCKEY 2 LLC AND PLAYER/PARENT AGREEMENT

This AGREEMENT is entered into in the State of Arizona between _____, born on _____ ("The Player") and jointly and severally by the Player's parent and/or legal guardian, _____, residing at _____, ("The Parent") and *Hockey²* LLC ("The Club"), a hockey development program for the spring 2011 hockey season, which is defined as lasting from the date of the first preparation camp, Date _____ until the completion of our spring tournaments. It is understood that the Parties **intend to be legally bound by this Agreement**, and that this Agreement was signed in, and is enforceable, in the State of Arizona, and that all references to the Player include males and females.

1. The Parent understands that if the Player resigns or otherwise voluntarily terminates his/her participation for any reason after signing this agreement, the player is not entitled to a refund of the Player Fee and must pay the entire remaining balance of the Player Fee.
2. The player agrees to play for *Hockey²* LLC AAA program in the spring 2011 in the tournaments selected by his family. Tournaments selected: _____
3. The Player agrees that he/she will attend all of the Club's ice practices, games, off-ice training, instructional sessions and organized team meetings, except when prevented from doing so for educational or medical reasons, in which case, the player will request permission in advance (when reasonably possible to do so) to be absent. The program acknowledges that such permission will be granted for all reasonable requests. The player agrees that he/she will maintain his/her academic and educational course work at the/she highest-level possible.
4. The Player agrees to obey the laws of the State of Arizona and that he/she will maintain good citizenship and behavior at all program events, as well as in his/her everyday life, recognizing that his/her behavior is a reflection upon the program.
5. The Player agrees not to use vulgar or profane language, racial, ethnic or gender related slurs toward teammates, coaches, officials, opponents or spectators.
6. The Player agrees that alcohol, tobacco products, and all legally banned substances, which includes marijuana, cocaine, non-prescribed medications, including performance enhancing substances and other related drugs has no place in hockey and Player agrees not participate in such use.
7. The Player recognizes that there is no place for violent or overly aggressive play in hockey where the obvious intent is to injure or harm another player, and agrees not to participate in such conduct.
8. The Parent agrees to respect and show appreciation for the program coaches and staff who are doing the best to present a positive environment to their athletes. Parent further agrees not to yell, taunt, threaten or inflict physical violence upon any player, coach, official or spectator at any Club events/functions.
9. The Parent agrees to be responsible for the financial commitment made in this agreement (which includes the payment of a Registration Fee and camp fee), even in the event that Player's Club or playing privileges are suspended and/or terminated for any reason, including but not limited to disciplinary, injury or illness, and understand this to mean that in no case will the Player Fee be prorated for any portion of the tournaments.
10. The Parent agrees that the Registration fee is non-refundable. Once the Player is placed on a team that fee is credited to the Player Fee. If the Player declines his/her position on a team, after the date designated by the Club, the Player will **not** be entitled to receive a refund.





11. The Parent understands that the Parent is responsible for the travel of the Player to and from the tournament. The Parent is also responsible for the hotel, food, equipment and all necessary costs relating to the Player during tournaments

12. The Parent understands that the Club may, at their sole discretion, based on past payment history, or other sound business practice, elect to require the full payment of player fees once a the Player is placed on a team.

13. The Player understand that he/she is responsible for fines or costs assessed for damage to facilities, locker rooms, etc., used in conjunction with Club's practices, games or other team events which are caused by the above named player.

14. The Parent understands that any discounts will be forfeited if any payments are not made on a timely basis.

15. The Parent understands that the Club is entitled to assess a reasonable charge for any returned check or credit card charge.

16. The Player and Parent agree to abide by all rules and regulations of each tournament, **Hockey²** LLC, and the Bobcats AAA program.

17. The Program does not guarantee nor promise that it can improve the college or professional hockey potential of the player or guarantee equal playing time. However, the Club will provide, to the best of its ability, the best environment, coaches and skills development, to assist the Player in realizing his/her full hockey potential.

18. The Player and Parent will sign the **Hockey²** LLC Waiver of Liability form.

19. The Player and Parent agree that Hockey 2 LLC may utilize the Parent's e-mail / mailing addresses and Player photographs, pictures and likenesses for promotional purpose. The Player and Parent acknowledge that failure to abide by the rules set forth in this agreement constitutes a breach of this Agreement and subjects the Player and his/her Parents to disciplinary action and possible expulsion from the program.

By signing this agreement, I hereby agree to submit all claims or disputes of any kind arising out of or related to the hockey program including, without limitation, personal injury, to binding arbitration. I understand and agree that I have waived my right to pursue any such claims in court and that I voluntarily waive my right to a jury trial. The arbitration shall be conducted in within the state of Arizona, county of Maricopa, in accordance with the arbitration procedures adopted and published by **Hockey²** LLC (which may adopt the arbitration rules of each tournament), or in the absence thereof, by way of the American Arbitration Association unless other arrangements are agreed to between the parties.

We hereby agree to the terms of this Agreement, acknowledge that we have read, understand and agree to abide by the rules and regulations set forth herein, and agree to be legally bound by this agreement.

Waiver of Liability, Release

Assumption of Risk & Indemnity Agreement

It is the purpose of this agreement to exempt, waive, release, relieve and hold harmless Hockey 2 LLC, its affiliate associations, local associations, member teams, event hosts, other participants, coaches, officials, sponsors, advertisers, and each of them, their officers, directors, agents, owners, and employees (hereafter referred to as the "Releases") from and against liability or claims of any sort arising out of or related in any way to hockey or hockey related activities engaged in by Releases including without limitation for personal injury, property damage, and wrongful death, whether or not caused by negligence of the Releases

For and in consideration of the undersigned participant's registration with Hockey 2 LLC., its affiliates, local associations and member teams (all referred to together as H2) and being allowed to participate in H2 events and member team activities, participant (and the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of participant, if applicable) waive, release and relinquish any and all claims for liability and cause(s) of action of any sort including, without limitation, for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death occurring to participant, arising out of or related to participation in H2 events, member team activities, the sport of ice hockey, and/or activities incidental thereto, whenever or however they occur and for such period said activities may continue, and by this agreement any such claims, rights, and causes of action that participant (and participant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s), if applicable) may have are hereby waived, released and relinquished, and participant (and parent(s)/guardian(s), if applicable) does(do) so on behalf of my/our and participant's heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

Participant (and participant's parent(s)/guardian(s), if applicable) acknowledge, understand and assume all risks relating to ice hockey and any member team activities, and understand that ice hockey and member team activities involve risks to participant's person including bodily injury, partial or total disability, paralysis and death, and damages which may arise there from and that I/we have full knowledge of said risks. These risks and dangers may be caused by the negligence of the participant or the negligence of others, including the "Releases" identified herein. These risks and dangers include, but are not limited to, those arising from participating with bigger, faster and stronger participants, and these risks and dangers will increase if participant participates in ice hockey and member team activities in an age group above that which participant would normally participate in. I/We further acknowledge that there may be risks and dangers not known to us or not reasonably foreseeable at this time. Participant (and participant's parent(s)/guardian(s), if applicable) acknowledge, understand and agree that all of the risks and dangers described throughout this agreement, including those caused by the negligence of participant and/or others, are included within the waivers, releases and relinquishments described herein.

I/We agree to abide by and be bound under the rules of Hockey 2 LLC, and all tournament rules, including the By-Laws and Rules of Conduct of Hockey 2 LLC and the arbitration clause provisions, as published or made available by Hockey 2 LLC from time to time as a condition to participate in Hockey 2 LLC activities.

Participant (and participant's parent(s)/guardian(s), if applicable) acknowledge, understand and assume the risks, if any, arising from the conditions and use of ice hockey rinks and related premises and acknowledge and understand that included within the scope of this waiver and release by way of example and not by way of limitation is any cause of action (including any cause of action based on negligence) arising from the performance, or failure to perform, maintenance, inspection, supervision or control of said areas and for the failure to warn of dangerous conditions existing at said rinks, for negligent selection of certain Releases, or negligent supervision or instruction by Releases. If the law in any controlling jurisdiction renders any part of this agreement unenforceable, the remainder of this agreement shall nevertheless remain enforceable to the full extent, if any, allowed by controlling law.

This agreement affects your legal rights, and you may wish to consult an attorney concerning this agreement.

Participant (and participant's parent(s)/guardian(s), if applicable) agree if any claim, action or arbitration of any sort is commenced contrary to the waivers, releases or relinquishments set forth in this agreement, including without limitation claims for participant's personal injury, or wrongful death, he/she shall defend, indemnify and save harmless (including payment of attorneys' fees and costs) Releases from any and all such claims or causes of action by whomever or wherever made or presented.

Participant (and participant's parent(s)/guardian(s), if applicable) acknowledge that they have been provided and have read the above paragraphs and have not relied upon any representations of Releases, that they are fully advised of the potential dangers of ice hockey and understand these waivers and releases are necessary to allow amateur ice hockey to exist in its present form. Significant exclusions may apply to each tournament's insurance policies, which could affect any coverage. For example, there is no liability coverage for claims of one player against another player. Read your brochure carefully and, if you have any questions, contact the tournament director.
