### DAY 1                      LOS ANGELES /PARIS

Group meeting at Los Angeles LAX Airport. Check-in formalities. Flight Los Angeles / Paris CDG. Meal and snack served on board.

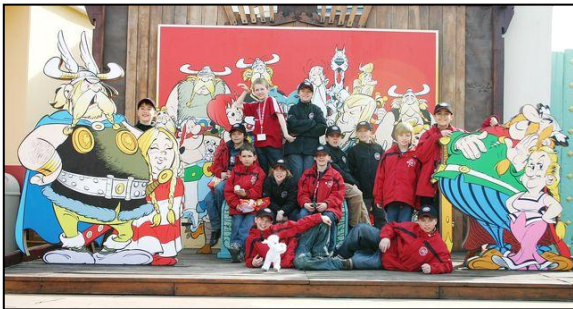
### DAY 2                      PARIS

Arrival at Paris CDG Airport. Customs formalities. Luggage pick-up. Meeting with your team guide. Transfer by coach to the centre of Paris. **Visit of the “Eiffel Tower”**: while rising the tower, you will see the extraordinary architectural audacity of this edifice. At the top of the tower (324 meters high), you will overlook the whole city of Paris. **Lunch included for the group**. **Spare time and shopping on the world famous avenue the “Champs Elysees”**. Transfer to the hotel. Dinner not included and overnight accommodation at the hotel for the group.



### DAY 3                      PARIS / THEME PARK

Breakfast at the hotel for the group. Transfer by coach to **EITHER** the “**Parc Asterix**”. Gauls, Romans, Goths, Egyptians... and let's not forget the Pirates! Discover the secrets of all the Asterix characters **OR** “**Disneyland Paris**” where you will enjoy the magic of all your favourite Disney characters and **Walt Disney Studios** to discover the world of movies, cartoons and television. Lunch not included for the group in the theme park chosen. Transfer back to Paris. **Dinner included for the group** on the “**Butte Montmartre**” which is the artistic quarter in Paris. **City tour by night** in coach. Overnight accommodation at the hotel for the group.



### DAY 4                      PARIS

Breakfast at the hotel for the group. **Narrated cruise on fly boats over the “Seine” River**: you will discover some of the greatest monuments of the “Historical Paris”. Lunch not included for the group. **Spare time in the afternoon**. Dinner not included and overnight accommodation at the hotel for the group.

## DAY 5                      PARIS / HONFLEUR / CAEN    175 miles / ~ 3h

Breakfast at the hotel for the group. Transfer by coach to Honfleur. **Guided visit of the scenic city of Honfleur**, place of birth of Samuel de Champlain. **Lunch included for the group**. **Visit-tasting in a cheese farm** in the hearth of Normandy. Road to Caen. **Welcome by the host families**. Dinner and overnight accommodation in host families for players. Dinner not included and accommodation at the hotel for parents and coaches.



## DAY 6                      CAEN AND ITS AREA

Breakfast in host families for players and at the hotel for parents and coaches. Transfer by coach. **Guided tour of the D-Day Normandy landings beaches**. You will discover those emotional and historical places where the Allies' troops landed with courage and strategy to break the Atlantic Wall built by the German forces and help to free Europe: American soldiers cemetery, Omaha beach... **Lunch included for the group**. **Visit of the Caen Memorial** to remember and understand the events of World War II, the biggest conflict of all mankind. Way back to Caen. **Beginning of the International Pee wee Tournament of Caen**. **Game in accordance with the tournament schedule**. Dinner and overnight accommodation in host families for players. Dinner not included and accommodation at the hotel for parents and coaches.



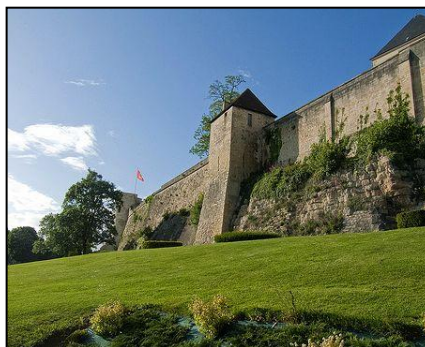
## DAY 7                      CAEN INTERNATIONAL PEEWEE TOURNAMENT

## DAY 8                      CAEN INTERNATIONAL PEEWEE TOURNAMENT

**Players & Coaches:** Breakfast in host families and at the hotel for coaches. **Games in accordance with the tournament schedule**. Lunch in the tournament program for players and coaches. **Final Games**. **Awards Ceremony**. Dinner in the tournament program for players and coaches (or in host families for players). Overnight accommodation in host families for players. Dinner not included and accommodation at the hotel for coaches.

**Parents:** Breakfast at the hotel. **Spare day**. Meals not included. Overnight accommodation at the hotel.



## DAY 9

## CAEN / SAINT-MALO / MONT-SAINT-MICHEL Round trip 230 miles / ~ 4h30

Breakfast in host families for players and at the hotel for parents and coaches. Transfer by coach to **Saint-Malo**. **Spare time in the sailors' city**. Its architecture is the testimony of twelve centuries of a colourful relationship between the city and the sea! You can visit the town from the city walls and discover an outstanding landscape or just have a walk on the beach. **Lunch included for the group**. Road to the **Mont-Saint-Michel**, "**Wonder of the West**". This village, hung up on the top of its hill in the middle of the sea, shows a beautiful architecture and the incredible show of the tide. **Spare time in the city and guided visit of the Abbey**. Way back to Caen. Dinner and overnight accommodation in host families for players. Dinner not included and accommodation at the hotel for parents and coaches.



## DAY 10

## CAEN / PARIS / LOS ANGELES

Breakfast in host families for players and at the hotel for parents and coaches. Transfer by coach to the Roissy Charles de Gaulle airport in Paris. Check-in for your departure flight. Lunch not included for the group. Flight Paris CDG / Los Angeles. Meal and snack served on board. Arrival to Los Angeles LAX airport. Luggage pick-up.

**Beware: This program will be definitive only according to the agreement of the tournament, host families, tourist attractions and according to the flight schedule. Non contractual pictures.**

### **INFORMATIONS GENERALES**

**Coach rules:** Coach regulation in France is very strict (many controls, limited driving hours...). Drivers are not allowed to overpass 9 hours of driving per day (including break times) in a range of 12 hours per day.

**Free Meals in the program:** Allow 10 to 20 Euro per lunch and 20 to 35 Euro per dinner.

**Jet-Lag:** There is a nine hour jet-lag between France and California. It's 9.00 am in L.A. while it's 6.00 pm in Paris.

**Hotel:** The European hotel rooms are less spacious than North American hotel rooms!

They can welcome 3 people (2 adults and a child). For families, we will provide you 2 or 3 side by side rooms.

**Visits:** According to your choice and to the possibilities, **we can change some visits of this program but at least 3 months prior to departure!**

## REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT PLAN

The registration will become effective at receipt of your complete file, which should include:

- **A deposit of 250 EUR per person to block a spot for your team. A payment plan will be sent to you after receiving the first account. A payment every two or three months should be planned.**
- **The complete list** of all participants with last names, first names and dates of birth + **Team Roster**
- **The rooming list** for parents first then for parents and players

**The last payment must be cashed at least 60 days prior to the departure date: before February the 25<sup>th</sup> 2011**

**Player rate 1390 Euro per person without compulsory airport taxes and without insurance**

**Coach & Parent rate 1650 Euro per person without compulsory airport taxes and without insurance**

**This rate does not include compulsory airport taxes of 350.00 EURO per person at this time (Amount to be confirmed on the ticket printing date in February 2011)**

- ⇒ **Rate calculated on a 40 person group basis** (16 players by two in host families and in triple/quadruple occupancy rooms at the hotel + 22 parents and 2 coaches in double/twin or triple occupancy rooms).
- ⇒ **The price can change depending on the exact number of persons participating in that trip.**
- ⇒ **There is an extra fee for single room (on request).**
- ⇒ **A child under 12 (not player) sharing his parent's room will get a 15% discount on the parent rate basis (without airport taxes and insurance).**

## The price does include:

- Flight Los Angeles / Paris round trip
- The extra airfare for one hockey bag per player
- Transportation by Deluxe coach during the whole length of the trip (excepted on days 7 and 8: tournament days)
- Hotel\*\* accommodation for 8 nights in double/twin or triple occupancy rooms with continental breakfast for parents and coaches in Paris and Caen
- Hotel\*\* accommodation for 3 nights in triple/quadruple occupancy rooms with continental breakfast for players in Paris
- Accommodation for 5 nights with dinner and breakfast in host families for players in Caen
- 4 lunches + 1 dinner for the group (+ 2 lunches and 2 dinners for players and coaches in the tournament program)
- Services from a guide during the whole length of the trip

**\*LUGGAGE ALLOWANCE**

Each passenger is allowed by the airline company to register 1 suitcase (23 kilos maximum) for the baggage hold and 1 handbag (limited size). Each player can register one hockey bag as an extra luggage (the extra fees are included in our player rate).

**PRICE REVISION**

The prices published in this program were determined in accordance with the followings:

- ⇒ Transport cost based on current price of petrol
- ⇒ Exchange rate
- ⇒ Necessary charges and taxes such as port and airport taxes

Should one of these data change significantly, we reserve ourselves the right to modify our prices.

**FORMALITY**

- A valid passport is required for all U.S. citizens and foreign national entering France
- Each passenger must hold a return flight ticket
- For **minor children travelling alone**, an authorization letter from their parents or tutors is also required

**CANCELLATION POLICY**

Should a customer cancel a reservation, cancellation charges will apply in accordance with the following:

- From August 2010 .....**150 EURO per person**
- From 75 to 61 days prior to the day of departure .....25% of the overall cost of the trip
- From 60 to 21 days prior to the day of departure .....50% of the overall cost of the trip
- From 20 to 8 days prior to the day of departure .....75 % of the overall cost of the trip
- Less than 7 days prior to the day of departure .....100% of the overall cost of the trip

Should a participant not present himself on the day of departure, should he not be able to present the necessary documents, or should he leave during the journey, whatever the reason, no refund or compensation can be expected.

**INSURANCE**

**INTERNATIONAL HOCKEY TOURS** advises you to subscribe to all the guarantees in order to be compensated in case of any unforeseeable events that could arise before or during your journey. You may check with your own insurance or with your bank regarding your credit card. Usually, if you settle your trip by credit card, you may have a cancellation insurance included. Your insurance will allow you to be reimbursed notably of cancellation fees charged by IHT in case of cancellation for medical reason. In order to travel, **you MUST have CIVIL LIABILITY insurance** and we will request a certificate. If you do not have one, we can subscribe for you to this insurance on demand. The contract we provide you includes CIVIL LIABILITY – RAPATRIATION – MEDICAL CARE – LUGGAGE insurances for the price of 40 EUR per person. Documentation is available upon request only.
